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1. ABOUT RRU:

Rashtriya Raksha University, Gujarat, India , pioneering security and police university of India, under the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India , offers comprehensive educational programs at Bachelor, Master and PhD level to the students and offers training to the law enforcement officials, police establishments, paramilitary forces , state arm police forces , central arm police force , security and intelligence agencies and government officials in the area of Security, Policing, Forensics, Cyber Security, Judiciary and Intelligence at National and International level.

Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU) is destined to become a global leader in security education with a goal to maintain international standards and to offer dynamic, excellent learning and research opportunities. The University is committed to the advancement and dissemination of education, research and training of the highest caliber in the field of security and policing.

2. OBJECTIVE:

- To facilitate the quick and easy admission for international students at Rashtriya Raksha University.
- To foster a secure environment that will draw foreign students to adopt a holistic approach, in order to achieve capabilities, according to the needs and expectations.
- To make Rashtriya Raksha University a preferred destination for international students.

3. GUIDELINES:

- Supernumerary seats for Foreign Nationals are also available for which the University retains the right.
- Candidates holding passports issued by foreign countries and People of Indian Origin (PIO), Non-Resident Indian (NRI) who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools or colleges in foreign countries or who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries are included as foreign nationals and shall be considered as an international student.
- This will include the students studying in schools or colleges situated in foreign countries even if they are affiliated to Boards of Secondary Education or Universities located in India, but will not

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include students studying in those schools or colleges (situated in India) and affiliated to the Boards of Secondary Education or Universities of the foreign countries.

- Language of Instruction shall be English for all programs. English Language proficiency is mandatory for all the students. (If required Online English Language test shall be conducted before admission)

- Refund Policy:

4. IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE FOR ONLINE APPLICATION:

- a) The Candidate must ensure that e-mail address and mobile number provided in an online application form is their own (which cannot be changed later) as communication would be sent by RRU through e-mail or SMS.
- b) Online application form cannot be withdrawn once it is submitted successfully and no application fees shall be refunded.
- c) Application form of candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.

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d) A candidate is allowed to submit only one application form for each program. If a candidate submits more than one application form, the candidature is likely to be cancelled.

i) Request for change in any particular in the application form shall not be entertained after closing of the correction window.

a) However, a chance may be given to the candidates to correct/modify/edit some of the particular(s) of the application form online only, during the correction window.

5. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- The candidate, seeking admission to the UG/PG program(s) may apply through online mode by submitting necessary documents and application fees.
- The admission shall be confirmed provided applicants attain the set eligibility criteria of the University with the submission of necessary documents.
- RRU International Admission Cell (IAC) will issue a 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' to confirm the candidate's admission.
- Accepted candidates are required to settle the tuition fees per semester (in Foreign Currency or Equivalent Indian currency) to obtain the final admission letter. This document is essential for fulfilling visa requirements in respective country.
- The students shall notify the International Cell about the payment of tuition fees with proof of payment.

6. STEPWISE PROCEDURE:

Step 1:

- I. Prospective international students are required to submit applications for undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) courses using a separate form designated for foreign nationals with application fees.

- II. Documents to be submitted with application separately for admission.
 - Copy of Passport
 - Marksheet / grade sheet of standard 10 (Level – O) / Standard 12 (Level-A) for admission into UG level program
 - Marksheet / grade sheet of standard 10 (Level – O) / Standard 12 (Level-A) / College exams – degree marksheets for admission into PG/ Master level program

Step 2:

Upon satisfying the admission criteria and verification of documents , the RRU International Admission Cell (IAC) will issue a 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' to confirm the candidate's admission.

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Step 3:

Accepted candidates are required to settle the tuition fees per semester (in Foreign Currency or Equivalent Indian currency) to obtain the final admission letter. This document is essential for fulfilling visa requirements in respective country.

Step 4:

Upon the approval of visas, students should inform the university of their travel plans, providing details of their itinerary. This notification enables the university to make the necessary arrangements for airport pick-up.

Step 5:

The candidate should report at RRU Hostel office and submit the below-mentioned documents along with the self-attested photocopies to get them verified by the RRU International Admission Cell (IAC).

The original certificates will be returned to the students after necessary verification.

Step 6:

As per government rules all international students entering India on a 'Student visa' will be medically examined by RRU.

Step 7:

- All foreigners (including foreigners of Indian origin) visiting India on long-term (more than 180 days) Student Visa, are required to get themselves registered with the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO) concerned having jurisdiction over the place where the foreigner intends to stay, within 14 days of arrival.
- Clearance from FRRO is compulsory and the candidate should register themselves at the given FRRO link to get the FRRO certificate which is mandatory for university records.
- RRU International Admission Cell will guide the students to get themselves registered with

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FRRO.

7. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:

- Application form duly filled with application fees.
- Academic documents like standard 10 (“O” Level) Standard 12 (“A” Level) , college marksheet / grade sheets of all years. Degree certificate.
- Copy of Passport
- English proficiency related documents / or equivalent is mandatory.
- Recommendation letter

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR VERIFICATION ON ARRIVAL :

- Admission letter issued by the University
- Fees payment details
- Original and valid Passport
- Passport Size Photographs (5)
- Birth certificate
- Bonafide Letter from School, College, or institute for the academic year mentioning nationality
- Residence Proof of the applicant.
- Marksheets/Degrees for the exams passed in the last academic year
- English proficiency related documents / or equivalent is mandatory.
